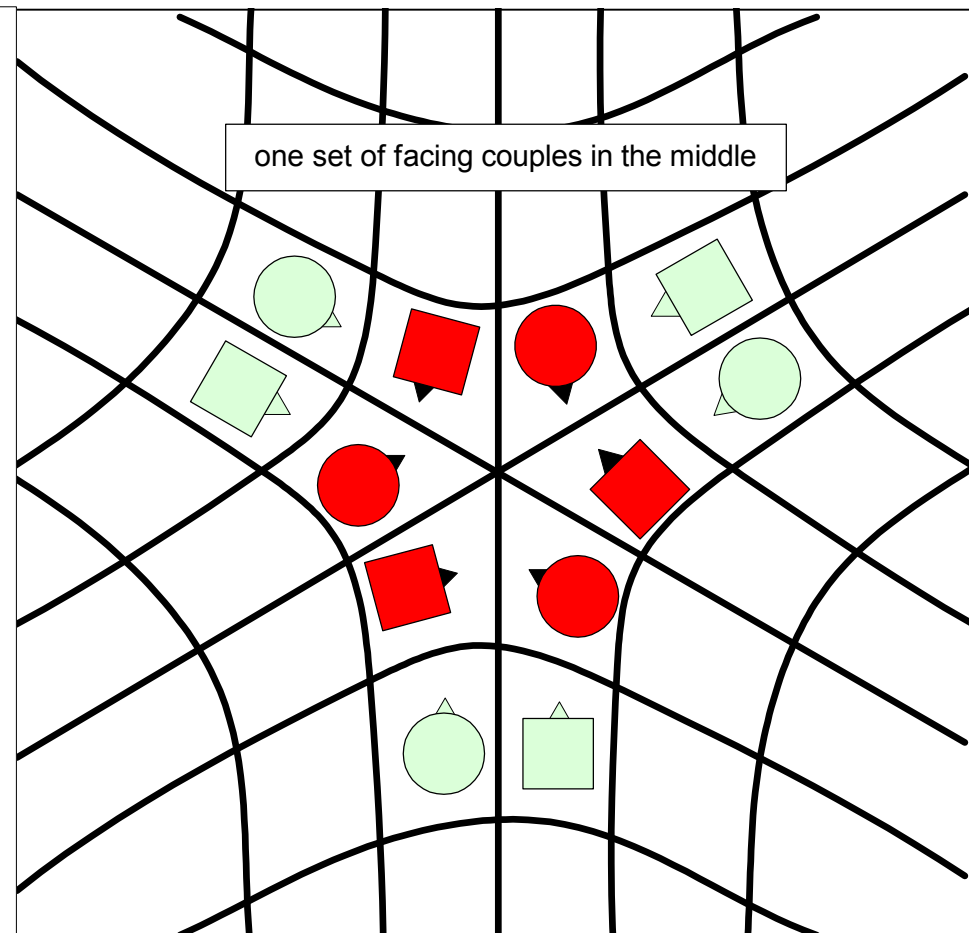


normal facing couples



one set of facing couples in the middle

### FACING COUPLES: Just like normal squares, can have one in the middle or more than one

Calls to "normal" facing couples are easy - they're just 4 dancer moves like normal squares. (OK, except that they're not quite facing head on, and there are 3 sets of couples doing it instead of 2...)

Calls to facing couples in the middle are more interesting. They're also not facing head on.

If you do a right and left thru, you don't get your partner back!

Pass the ocean is tricky the first time or two - after you pass thru and face in, you take right hands with a 'stranger'. But at least the left hand dancers can still 'hook'. Of course, that's a 3 hand hook...

Circle to a line? I think all 3 named dancers (e.g. Head Men) will break, and nobody turns under.

Flutterwheel will be a 3 hand star - pretty straight forward.

Calls from a wave - like spin the top - need you to step to a wave first. Of course, that's 3 mini waves and a 3 hand star. Then it's sort of normal.
